Superintendent's Report

Construction Update – Mark Law

They are still working on closing out remodeling projects and the stadium. They are projecting \$220,000 - \$225,000 in savings for the stadium. On remodeling projects (Elgin Elem. North and South, BTW Elem), a savings of \$200,000-\$220,000 is possible. Total overall savings is estimated at \$420,000 -\$445,000 and probably more once Baird Williams is closed out.

Middle School - Trap primers malfunctioned and are being replaced. Some vent stacks had become dislodged, loose or had been cut during construction and are being repaired. Work should be completed by Tuesday afternoon (11/17).
