HEAD START will also be at Elgin Elementary to enroll qualified 3 year olds

Pre-Kindergarten Information:

Elgin ISD offers a **full day pre-kindergarten** classes for children who are four years old on or before September 1, 2017, live in the district, and:

- have a limited ability to speak and/or comprehend the English language; or
- are homeless; or
- whose family income (must provide proof of income) allows the child to qualify for free or reduced lunch, TANF or food stamps; or
- active duty uniformed members, which includes parents or guardians, of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force or Coast Guard who are assigned to duty stations in Texas or who are Texans who have eligible children residing in Texas; or
- Guard and Reserve-Activated / Mobilized uniform members of the Texas National Guard-Army or Air Guard or the Activated / Mobilized members of the Reserve components of the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force or Coast Guard who are Texas residents regardless of the location of the reserve unit; or
- have military parents who are missing in action or who have died; or
- is or ever has been in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, Family Code.

Kindergarten registration will be held at your neighborhood elementary school

Kindergarten Information:

Any newly enrolling child who will be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2017, and who lives in the Elgin ISD is eligible to attend the district's **full-day kindergarten**. If you have a child who is eligible, please go by your neighborhood elementary school anytime between **3:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.** on **May 4th** or on **May 18th** to register.

Parents should bring the following to registration:

- Two months proof of recent income (pay stubs) for ***Pre-Kindergarten ONLY***.
- Proof of residence within the district (contract on house, lease agreement, actual title to house, or current utility bill, i.e. water, gas or electric)
- Child's official certified birth certificate **and** Child's social security card
- Child's immunization record (Kindergarten children **MUST** be immunized for DTP, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, HIB, HEP-A, Hep-B, and varicella. Pre-K children must have Hep-A, pneumococcal (PCV7), DTP, polio, measles, mumps, rubella, HIB, Hep-B and varicella). Immunization requirements may change so check the EISD website for updates.
- Valid identification card of the person who is registering the child.

You should come to registration even if you do not have all of the above information. Parents will be given notice of when these items are due.
