

**RESOLUTION OF THE  
ELGIN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD  
REGARDING HAZARDOUS TRAFFIC CONDITIONS**

WHEREAS, Education Code 42.155(d) allows the Board of Trustees of Elgin Independent School District to obtain supplemental state funding for transportation regular, otherwise ineligible students who live within two miles of their school would be subject to hazardous traffic conditions if they walked to school.

WHEREAS, the TEA handbook on School Transportation Allotments requires the Board to adopt language providing the definition of hazardous traffic conditions applicable to the District and identifying the specific hazardous areas for which such funding is requested.


WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges the Education Code 42.155(d) provisions stating that a hazardous condition exists where no walkway is provided and students must walk along or cross a freeway or expressway, an underpass, an overpass or a bridge, an uncontrolled major traffic artery, an industrial or commercial area, or another comparable condition;


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

The board of Trustees of Elgin Independent School District has defined hazardous traffic conditions in the same manner as stated in Education Code 42.155(d) and has identified the follow specific hazardous areas in which such conditions exist.

## DESIGNATED HAZARDOUS TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

Definition of Hazardous Conditions: A hazardous condition exists when no walkway is provided and children must walk along or cross a freeway or expressway, an underpass or bridge, an uncontrolled major traffic artery, an industrial or commercial area or another comparable condition. Construction areas may be considered hazardous on an as-needed basis.

### ELGIN HIGH SCHOOL

Grades 9 – 12

### DESIGNATED HAZARDOUS AREAS

(Within two miles of campus)

**South of US 290 and East of State Highway 95 North:** This area requires that Elgin High School students receive hazardous transportation.

**Eagles Landing Subdivision:** This area requires that Elgin High School students receive hazardous transportation.

### ELGIN MIDDLE SCHOOL

Grades 6 – 8

### DESIGNATED HAZARDOUS AREAS

(Within two miles of campus)

**South of US 290 and East of State Highway 95 North:** This area requires that Elgin Middle School students receive hazardous transportation.

**Eagles Landing Subdivision:** This area requires that Elgin Middle School students receive hazardous transportation.

### ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

Grades PK - 5

### DESIGNATED HAZARDOUS AREAS

(Within two miles of campus)

### ELGIN ELEMENTARY

**ALL AREAS:** These areas require that Elgin Elementary students receive hazardous transportation

**Inside the area of Central Avenue, SH Hwy 95 North, North of US 290, North Main Street:** This area requires Elgin Elementary students receive hazardous transportation.

**Inside the area of Central Avenue, Harris Street, South Main Street, and US Hwy 290:** This area requires that Elgin Elementary students receive hazardous transportation.

**South of US 290:** This area requires that Elgin Elementary students receive hazardous transportation.

**NEIDIG ELEMENTARY**

Grades K - 5

**DESIGNATED HAZARDOUS AREAS**

(Within two miles of campus)

**ALL AREAS:** These areas require that Neidig Elementary students receive hazardous transportation

**Shenandoah & Creekside Subdivision:** This area requires Neidig Elementary students receive hazardous transportation.

**West Wind Subdivision:** This area requires Neidig Elementary students receive hazardous transportation.

**KB Homes Subdivision: Includes Bandera Woods Blvd, and Blanco Woods Blvd**

This area requires Neidig Elementary students receive hazardous transportation.

**Crescent Village Apartments:** This area requires Neidig Elementary students receive hazardous transportation.

**Elgin Meadows Subdivision:** This area requires Neidig Elementary students receive hazardous transportation.

**Eagles Landing Subdivision:** This area requires that Neidig Elementary students be provided hazardous transportation.

**BTW ELEMENTARY**

Grades K - 5

**DESIGNATED HAZARDOUS AREAS**

(Within two miles of campus)

**ALL AREAS:** These areas require that BTW Elementary students receive hazardous transportation

**Inside FM 3000, South Main Street, North of US Hwy 290**

**South of US Hwy 290**

**Inside South Main Street, Union Pacific Railroad Tracks, and US Hwy 290**

**Inside US Hwy 290, FM 3000, East of Railroad Tracks, Westbrook Lane and Taylor Street ( not including students on FM 3000)**
