- A government issued photo ID of the person registering a student
- The student's original birth certificate or a certified copy
- The student's social security number (Optional)
- Information about special programs to meet the educational need of the student such as special education or bilingual education
- Up-to-date immunization records (immunization records are required before the student can be enrolled)
- Proof of residency

**Elgin ISD Online Registration Option**

Welcome and thank you for your interest in Elgin ISD for the 2021-2022 school year. **New student registration can be completed 100% online** without a need for a face-to-face process. New student registration is available online starting **July 19, 2021** for PK through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Parents are able to upload **all** necessary registration documents electronically. **Face-to-Face Registration Requirements  
and COVID-19 Precautions**

Elgin ISD is also offering two **face-to-face registration** opportunities for families that are not able to or need support registering online. There will be certain requirements that must be followed by those choosing to register face-to-face. Requirements are as follows:

1. Stay home if you have COVID-19, have been exposed to COVID-19 or you are exhibiting COVID-19 like symptoms (complete registration online)
2. **LIMITED ACCESS.** Only one person per family will be allowed in the building (No children/students or other members of the family will be allowed in the building)
3. **Face coverings are strongly encouraged** throughout the registration process
4. All visitors must practice **social distancing to the greatest extent possible**
