

QUARANTINE Return to Learn Criteria

Your child has been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 and is required to self-quarantine for 10 days and may not return to campus during that time.

Steps to Take

Stay home and monitor your health

- Stay home for 10 days after the last contact with a person who has COVID-19.
- Watch for fever (100°F), cough, shortness of breath, or [other symptoms](#) of COVID-19
- If possible, stay away from others, especially people who are at [higher risk](#) for getting very sick from COVID-19

Return to Learn Criteria

Your child may **not** return to school until one of the following criteria boxes have been met:

A	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 10 days after the last close contact* and • No symptoms
B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 7 days after the last close contact* and • receiving a negative test result (test must occur on day 5 or later) and • No symptoms
C	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If your child develops symptoms, immediately isolate your child and contact your local public health authority or healthcare provider and campus nurse

After stopping quarantine,

- Watch for symptoms until 14 days after exposure.
- If your child develops symptoms, immediately isolate your child and contact your local public health authority or healthcare provider and campus nurse.
- Wear a mask, stay at least 6 feet from others, wash their hands, avoid crowds, and take other steps to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

*If your child lives in the same household as a person who has tested positive for COVID-19, quarantining for "close contact" begins the last day of the positive person's 10-day contagious period. Your child must quarantine until the Return to Learn criteria (A, B, or C) is met.
