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Parents, if your student exhibits COVID-19 related symptoms that are not normal for them, or they have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, you will need to notify your student’s campus and keep them at home. It is also encouraged to seek medical attention if conditions are not normal for your child or the conditions worsen.

If your child begins to exhibit any of these symptoms while at school, you will be contacted by the school nurse or other school official to pick your student up immediately.

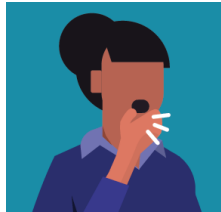

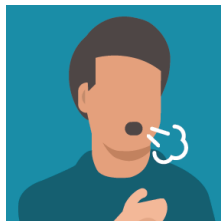
